


## February 2016 block of the month – bring to March meeting

### 9" Spool and Bobbin

These quilt examples are just two ideas for using this block in a whole quilt. This example was created with just two colorways of the same block. The blocks were all in the same place on each quilt, but half of the blocks in the right quilt were just rotated 90 degrees.



Finished size, 9", this block will measure 9 1/2"

Select two or more yellow and blue fabrics:

Light yellow or pale blue for background patches **A** and **B** plus contrasting bright or light blues or bright yellows for the **C** and **D** patches.


Cut Squares as follows:

**A:** 2 squares 5"x5" (background)


**B:** 2 squares 3 1/8" x 3 1/8" – cut diagonally to make four (4) right triangles (background)

**C:** 1 square 5 3/8" x 5 3/8"- cut diagonally to make two right triangles (contrast)


**D:** 2 squares 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" (contrast)




Assemble the Block: Attach one **D** square to short sides of two **B** triangles. You will have a new right triangle when done. Repeat with second **D** square fabric square and two **B** triangles.



Attach both **C** right triangles to one of the units just made.



Attach the **A** squares to the new squares.



Sew the new double units.
