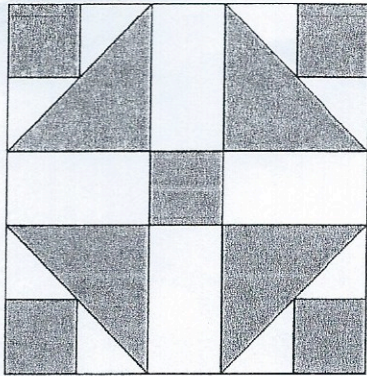


Grandmother's Choice

10 1/2" (10" finished)



Fabrics: Reds

Dark red: Cut 5 — 2 1/2" squares

Cut 2 — 4 7/8" squares and cut once diagonally.

Light red or red on white: Cut 4 — 2 1/2" X 4 1/2" rectangles

Cut 4 — 2 7/8" squares and cut once diagonally for 8 half-square triangles.

Sew light triangles to 2 1/2" square as shown. Press toward the light triangles, then join to the dark triangle. Make 4 of these units, pressing toward the dark.

Assemble block as shown

below, pressing toward dark square

and dark triangles. Press the last 2 seams to the outside. Pressing in this way will allow the block to lie flatter.
